TEACHING

Because not all students learn the same way or have the same needs, Inalco has built a flexible yet intensive teaching program based on a communicative approach where learners divided into small groups (up to 12 participants per group) are given every opportunity to practice Arabic. Interactive activities such as commenting on movies, debating, delving into Arabic poetry, and analysing folklore and songs represent an invaluable way for assimilating both grammatical and cultural notions that otherwise could remain abstract.

Whether you are a beginner or already an advanced learner, you will get an amazing opportunity to practice speaking Arabic for 6 weeks, which will help you build confidence and competence. Whether you have studied standard Arabic or not, you will be trained to speak the language that people commonly use.



PROFESSORS

OBJECTIVES OF THE SUMMER COURSE

In order to be able to face different communication situations, it is necessary to acquire several languages.

Boost your spoken Arabic (Moroccan, Algerian, Libyan or Egyptian)

If you are planning to live or to do research in an Arab country, if you want to grasp what people are saying and to make yourself understood, you need to speak the national or the local dialect.

After this six-week intensive program, if you are already acquainted with Arabic, whatever your level, you can expect to improve significantly not only your linguistic skills but also the pragmatics of the language (what to say to whom at the right time).

Each level will focus on comprehension and speaking skills, using repetition as well as interactions, along with grammatical explanations.

- For beginners in the dialect, the objectives are to become efficient in basic ordinary interactions: meeting someone, buying something, expressing basic needs (ordering food and drinks, booking accommodation...), travelling and asking for directions. For those who already have a certain degree of exposure to standard Arabic, our trained staff will help the learner take full advantage of this competence in learning a spoken variety, as well as guide the student in recalibrating previously acquired speech habits to match those of the dialect they are studying
- For intermediate learners, the aim is to be able to reach a level which allows you to describe something or someone, to give your opinion and arguments, to describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes and ambitions.

Enhance your level of standard Arabic

Standard Arabic is the language of the written word, of official speeches and of the media throughout the Arab world from Morocco to Oman. It allows communication across time and enables readers to access writings that are more than a millennium and a half old, including the sacred texts of Islam. It is not only the language of the prestigious classical heritage, it is also the written language of the present, which has experienced a prodigious growth and profound changes in the last century. It is the living language of modern Arab culture.

Students will be placed in different level groups according to their previous knowledge and skills.
