#### 1. Documents to be included in the application whatever your administrative situation:

- A birth certificate with a translation of this into French **or** a legible copy of your valid passport **or** an identity card with a translation of this into French;
- 2 normal (DL) size envelopes (2 international reply coupons for 20g postage) labeled with the candidate's address;
- 3 large (C4) envelopes to fit the application (3 international reply coupons for 50g postage) labeled with the candidate's address;
- A certificate of French Language Proficiency.

#### 2. Documents to be included by candidates who are Asylum Seekers:

- Proof of your asylum application.

#### 3. Additional documents to be included with the application according to your situation:

##### Situation [A1](#) (see page 3 of the application form):

- Transcripts of marks obtained in the two previous academic years and in the first semester of the current academic year;
- At the time of the definitive registration:
  - a photocopy of the high school diploma with a translation of this carried out by a French official service or a sworn translator.
  - an original copy of your high school diploma.

##### Situation [A2](#) (see page 3 of the application form):

- A photocopy of your high school diploma and a translation of this provided by a French official service or a sworn translator.
- The transcript of marks obtained in the different tests comprising the high school diploma;
- At the time of the definitive registration: an original copy of your high school diploma.

**Situation B1 (see page 3 of the application form):**

- Transcripts of marks obtained in the two previous academic years and in the first semester of the current academic year;
- At the time of the definitive registration:
  - a photocopy of your high school diploma and a translation of this provided by a French official service or a sworn translator; a photocopy of the certificate of access to higher education in your country for the studies you have chosen, with an official translation of this: you should request this document from the administrative services of your country, after having fulfilled the conditions: successful completion of a competitive examination, special examination, application interview, etc.
  - an original copy of your certificate of access to higher education in your country.

**Situation B2 (see page 3 of the application form):**

- A photocopy of your high school diploma and a translation of this provided by a French official service or a sworn translator.
- The transcript of marks obtained in the different tests comprising the high school diploma;
- At the time of the definitive registration:
  - the certificate of access to higher education in your country for the studies you have chosen: you should request this certificate from the administrative services of your country after having fulfilled the conditions: successful completion of a competitive examination, special examination, application interview, etc.
  - an original copy of your certificate of access to higher education in your country with an official translation of this.

**Situation B3 (see page 3 of the application form):**

- A photocopy of your high school diploma and a translation of this provided by a French official service or a sworn translator.
- Certificate of entry into higher education in your country, which the administrative services of your country should provide you with for these chosen studies (competitive examination, special examination, etc.);
- The transcript of marks obtained in the different tests comprising the high school diploma;
- At the time of the definitive registration: an original copy of your certificate of access to higher education in your country with an official translation of this.
