- 2-week program with classes from Monday to Friday
- 50 hours of teaching and tutoring: 3 hours of language classes in the morning and 2 hours of French-language related workshops in the afternoon
- Optimum class size, limited to 13 students
- Cultural activities

- 6 ECTS credits granted upon successful completion of the course
- Examination and certification included: an official TCF *Test de* Connaissances en Français – will be organized during the program
- Qualified and experienced French (FSL) teachers

- In addition to the cultural activities included in the course, there will be several museum visits, e.g. the Musée d'Orsay
- A cruise on the river Seine on one of the famous bateaux mouches is included
- Students will be able to meet and talk with Inalco undergraduate and graduate students, some of whom will act as 'buddies' during the course
